DON'T WORRY. HAVE FAITH!

## BIG IDEA

Jesus wants us to live in faith not worry and fear. He cares for the flowers in the field and will take care of our needs too.

## MEMORY VERSE

Verse: Luke 12:27-28a “Consider how the wild flowers grow. They do not labor or spin. Yet I tell you, not even Solomon in all his splendor was dressed like one of these. If that is how God clothes the grass of the field....how much more will he clothe you!

Phrase: Don't worry. Have faith!”

## PREPARATION & MATERIALS

- colored paper
- markers or crayons
- wide popsicle sticks
- scissors (EM provides)
- stickers (optional)
- glue

## INSTRUCTIONS

Spread out among the children so all of the children are near to a Team Member. Pass out colored paper, markers, popsicle sticks, scissors, stickers and glue.

Team Member show examples of hand print flowers. Help kids trace and cut out their hand prints. They can arrange several on a popsicle stick to make a daisy-like flower or a single handprint to form a tulip-like flower. Color popsicle stick and add green leaves.

While they work tell them the story of the rich young ruler (Luke 12:13-21) and about how Jesus instructed his disciples not to worry (Luke 12:22-34).

If telling a bible story is not an option then simply repeat the phrase, “Don't worry. Have faith!”
